# Smith Questioned On Improvement Plans

DELAND — Road improvement, a traffic light at U.S. 92 and Marsh Road, and the city's airport dump were the major topics of questions fired at DeLand City Commissioner Deane Smith, guest speaker last night for the DeLand Highlands Betterment League.

Smith fielded the numerous queries about specific roads by stating that roads should be built and improved in the order of the greatest public need, not as favors to a few.

"I won't promise something I couldn't produce," said Smith, who's Democratic nominee for the Dist. 1 County Commission post. He added: "I will promise good government, however, and extending available county money as far as possible to every area."

He also commented that the county in the past hadn't had

much "good management" and mentioned obtaining government surplus machinery to help in road building and maintenance.
