

Attachment C: May 11 Allen Tractor Service Noise Incident Evidence

Supporting attachment for VCSO supervisory review request

Purpose and scope

This attachment summarizes the May 11, 2026 noise complaint involving a vehicle associated with Allen Tractor Service & Allen Plumbing, along with a limited prior related lane/passing concern for context. The purpose is to document the time, location, vehicle type, call number, and observed pattern in a concise format suitable for supervisory review.

Important limitation: The prior related passing/centerline item included below is not attributed to Allen Tractor Service & Allen Plumbing or any other specific company. The owner/operator of that prior truck was not identified. It is included only to show that resident complaints have included more than ordinary pass-by noise.

May 11, 2026 timeline

Time	Event summary
Approx. 8:19 a.m.	Vehicle associated with Allen Tractor Service & Allen Plumbing passed near the property. As it reached the area of the property line, the driver appeared to briefly downshift or trigger the engine/compression brake for approximately three seconds.
Approx. 9:19 a.m.	The vehicle returned northbound carrying a heavy load. Substantial exhaust/acceleration noise was observed from approximately Pine to Palmetto, followed by apparent engine/compression-brake noise as the driver decelerated or released the accelerator. By approximately 2103 Marsh Road, immediately after the property, the truck became noticeably quiet.
Approx. 9:31 a.m.	VCSO call/event 261310798 was created/listed as a Noise Complaint in the Deland district.

Prior related unsafe-passing / centerline concern

The following prior item is included for context only. It concerns a separate Marsh Road incident previously documented in an email to County/VCSO recipients. The owner/operator of the truck in this prior item was not identified and this attachment does not attribute that incident to Allen Tractor Service & Allen Plumbing, EDDY V, CFB, or any other specific operator.

In the prior email thread, the incident was described as a long semi tractor-trailer crossing the double-yellow centerline to pass another vehicle on Marsh Road in front of the residence at approximately 8:09 a.m. on April 15, 2026. This is relevant because resident complaints have included unsafe operation, lane/centerline concerns, and roadway-geometry concerns, not merely ordinary traffic noise.

Summary

Attachment C supports the supervisory review request by tying the May 11 noise complaint to a specific VCSO event number and providing a concise timeline and visual references. The prior related passing item is included only to show the broader pattern of resident-documented concerns involving heavy commercial vehicle operation, lane behavior, and roadway suitability on Marsh Road.
